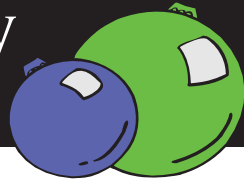
You can send these photo's either by e-mail to the listing above or get them to me so I can download them, it's going to be fun!!!

I hope that all of you have a safe and fun 2011 boating season, and I will see you on the water!

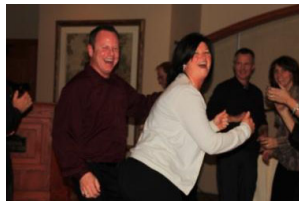

Lake Flaming Gorge Lucerne Marina Break Water update:

In November 2010, Bart Forsyth prepared a letter to the National forest Service expressing concerns with the existing breakwater at Lucerne Marina. The letter can be viewed on the Lake Flaming Gorge Yacht Club website at www.lfgyc.com.

The letter was written on behalf of all boating enthusiasts and others who have interest in protecting and safely utilizing Lucerne Marina and its facilities. A request was made for Forest Service assistance: 1) to make the necessary repairs to the existing breakwater; and 2) to install additional wave attenuation to provide full protection of the marina.

Since that time there have been ongoing discussions with the Forest Service regarding this issue. The Forest Service has been in the process of researching the details surrounding the existing breakwater, and have been good to share the information that has been uncovered. The next step will be to hold a meeting with the Forest Service, Flaming Gorge Corporation and other interested parties to further discuss the breakwater situation. It's looking like this meeting will be held sometime in April.
